Including: what activities, programming will occur on site, will families or only individuals be sheltered, who will decide who will be sheltered, how will individuals be chosen to be sheltered, will individuals with addiction issues be housed here, will this facility permit drug injections, who will be responsible for maintaining the property, both inside and in the surrounding area, will individuals be permitted to sleep on the sidewalk adjacent to the building after dark, how will this facility affect property values in the neighborhood - both commercial and residential, how will this facility impact the proposed new arena, what other locations has the city considered, what is the budget to renovate and then operate this facility, who is going to pay to operate this facility, how much money is the city of Saskatoon going to commit to finance this operation.
