**Comments:**

I would like to support Option 1 – Permit shared e-scooters on the public right-of-way.

The focus in the future by City administration should not be whether or not to permit shared e-scooters, but rather, how best to manage shared e-scooters, including more permanent docking and charging to provide both reliability to customers, and to prevent the abandonment of scooters on rights-of-way.

Further, thought should be given to the feasibility of bike share in Saskatoon.
