

The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2025

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 10054, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2025* (“Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council’s decision to update the Fringe Festival and Exhibition Week parking permit programs.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 10054, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2025*.

BACKGROUND

At its [December 18, 2024 Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the Community Services Division dated December 10, 2024 and resolved:

1. That the proposed amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw, 1991* be approved; and
2. That the City Solicitor be requested to make the necessary amendments to *Bylaw No. 7200, The Traffic Bylaw, 1991*.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS

In accordance with City Council’s instruction, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 10054, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2025* for City Council’s consideration.

The Bylaw updates the parking area boundary for the Fringe Festival and provides discretion to issue additional parking permits where there is a demonstrated need by the owner or occupant of a unit within the parking area and the availability of parking spots can accommodate the issuance of additional permits.
