

Saskatoon City Council will consider Bylaw No. 10066, *The Municipal Reserve Redesignation Bylaw, 2025* at its meeting to be held on Wednesday, March 26, 2025 at 6:00 p.m., Council Chambers, City Hall. The Bylaw provides for removal of Municipal Reserve designation from approximately 5.15 acres of land known as Larkhaven Industrial Park located in the Airport Business Area.

The removal of the designation will allow for future servicing of the land, as well as uses which do not fall within the acceptable uses for Municipal Reserve as defined in *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*.
