I want to speak about my personal experience in Saskatoon. I am a transgender woman coming from eastern europe but with experience in germany and uk

I want to say that some organization as saskatoon pride are not representing the community, their political agenda don't put people like myself first before their political agenda

With regards of the city, it feels like london 2010' where we lack educating people about the queer community! For example : I know there are some busses with the pride flag but just putting one doesn't actually make a strong statement like the slogan on some busses i saw in london(some people are gay/trans get over it!). If steps like these aren't made properly the discrimination rate won't drop.

Now as a high skill worker (first transgender woman to work/design drones in the entirety of north america) i ask you this: How would you feel that high trained queer workers leave saskatoon to find a better safer place? The problem you can see lies even with the youth where for them being edgy transphobic or homophobic is fun not because they are educated but because they have been told no from adults without making them understand! The drama we have is because the population hasn't been educated and this is the only step one can make, educate the population! It's also very embarrassing to be such anti canadian values in the current political form that we are in: over the south border queer people are targeted especially trans, and over here the american maga sentiment has infiltrated. I ask the persons who take a decision today to ask yourself , what is more canadian? Following the maga or following canadas tradition of acceptance? If what south of the border doesn't ring a bell i am afraid nobody will make you understand how a person like myself (trans, high skilled, making history for Saskatoon as we speak) would feel when the town is declared safe but I still hear people discriminating even inside these walls as I was informed!
