

The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2025

ISSUE

This report submits Bylaw No. 10072, *The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2025* (the “Bylaw”) for City Council’s consideration. The Bylaw implements City Council’s decision to create offences and corresponding penalties for providing false or misleading information in an application for a licence and allowing an animal other than a dog in an off-leash dog park.

RECOMMENDATION

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 10072, *The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2025*.

BACKGROUND

At its [March 26, 2025, Regular Business Meeting](#), City Council considered a report of the Community Services Division dated March 5, 2025 and resolved:

1. That proposed amendments to Bylaw No. 7860, *The Animal Control Bylaw, 1999*, be approved; and
2. That the City Solicitor be requested to make the necessary amendments to Bylaw No. 7860, *The Animal Control Bylaw, 1999*.
