Comments:

I urge council to support the speed limit reduction as part of the development of a neighbourhood bikeway on Munroe Ave. A safe north-south active transportation route in that area is needed to allow cycling and pedestrian traffic to move in and out of the university grounds. We have only to think back to the tragic death of Natasha Fox in 2023 on Wiggins Ave as she was trying to access the university with her small children to realize the importance of this piece of infrastructure. The creation of a neighbourhood bikeway on Munroe Ave between College Dr and 14th St is only the first part of an eventual connection allowing active transportation users to travel from the south of the city to the university. Again, I urge you to support this matter and also all subsequent phases of this important piece of active transportation infrastructure.
