Dear Your Worship and Council,

We have a serious issue around trying to provide basic washroom facilities in our city.

Taxpayers are funding enormously expensive test programs for limited success or improvement while we overlook the much more straight forward options we have at our disposal.

The City of Saskatoon is already using remote live video feed in our operations, so why are we not expanding this capability to include washrooms? The City Solicitor would have already dealt with any privacy issues through the existing program so adding new capability on a groundwork already laid would be simple.

All outdoor washroom facilities could be monitored and operated with a "Push to Call" system to centralize operations. Use one Commissionaire in a monitoring location to watch over and control access to all remote washrooms sites. Have another two commissionaires as a two person roving patrol to check on sites in person.

This option would provide access to washrooms in a day or night situation as well as enhanced ability to track vandalism and provide another safety contact point for emergency access.
