**Subject:** Comments - Board of Directors Saskatoon Pride - Sean Feucht Concert

Mayor Block, City Council, and Administration,

Saskatoon Pride wishes to express our frustration and concern that the artist Sean Feucht has been granted permission to perform on public property. Feucht is a MAGA-affiliated individual who has previously used recognized hate group 'The Proud Boys' as security detail. As an outspoken White Christian Nationalist, he has no qualms about sharing his anti-choice and anti-2SLGBTQIA+ viewpoints on a public stage, rallying his supporters behind a cause that perpetuates exclusionary and fascistic rhetoric. We feel that moving forward with platforming this individual would be a careless move that would send a clear message to all marginalized communities in our city: that discrimination is acceptable under the guise of free speech

This permit being given so quickly after Saskatoon's designation as a Safe City for 2SLGBTQIA+ individuals is as baffling as it is hugely disappointing. Saskatoon Pride, alongside several other queer community members, spoke directly as to why this motion should not pass, and their opinions were discarded. We are writing this letter, frankly, as a last resort. The continued failure to engage with the concerns of the city's most vulnerable citizens highlights the flimsiness of our so-called "Safe City" status, and points towards an underlying inability to protect the peace and well-being of disenfranchised peoples. We request that Sean Feucht have his permit revoked—in accordance with the multiple Canadian cities that have already taken action on this matter—and that the city make efforts to approach Pride for consultation on how to judge permit applications on public property in the future.

If Feucht is allowed to perform, we fear that the resulting backlash will actively jeopardize the mental and physical health of 2SLGBTQIA+ individuals in this city, as well as all those targeted by the MAGA agenda. Should this event go forward, we ask that you pull back on Saskatoon's declaration of Safe City status, as it is clear that our safety is valued only so long as it remains theoretical. Giving carte blanche to a prominent figurehead of a movement that denigrates large swathes of our community seems a poor way to keep the population protected.
