Over the last decade, the Swalewatchers group and others have consistently advocated for the preservation of the Northeast Swale, including what is known as the "Small Swale". With Native Grasslands being one of the most endangered ecosystems on the planet right now, it seems short-sighted to consider reducing the protection level for this area.

The Urban Park proposal is a boon for Saskatoon to celebrate our beautiful river valley and the swales. To reduce reduce the amount of protection for the swales goes against the historic position of City Council as voted in February, 2023. That vote demonstrated a commitment to conservation science. To vote differently in 2026 negates the original purpose and intent of preserving the swales.

I am requesting the Committee:

1. Propose a motion and vote NO to Recommendation 2: Approval of the 2026 Provisional National Urban Park Boundary in Appendix 3 based on the deficiencies of the boundaries, as shown in Appendix 4.
