

Dear Chair Greyeyes and Saskatoon Board of Police Commissioners,

In the 2026 Business Plan under Initiative 3 of the Balanced Enforcement, community feedback indicated “Holding repeat and high-risk offenders accountable is a high priority.”

In the most recent Retail Blitz from January, the news release stated “30 arrests were made; 15 of which were repeat offenders.”

There is a lot of public discussion about Police funding and how the SPS are being deployed in Saskatoon.

To that end, I sincerely request the following information for the 2025 year:

1. How much SPS funding went to deal with the top 5 repeat adult offenders in our City?
2. How much SPS funding went to deal with the top 5 repeat young offenders in our City?

To limit the time and resources required to gather this information, I am not asking for details such as demographics of the persons involved, location of where the offences took place or the type of offence that required SPS involvement.

I am also not asking for an exhaustive accounting review of this. Just ballpark figures quickly generated from a senior officer who would understand the time and costs involved.

My purpose for requesting this rough information is to understand the extent to which repeat offenders take up SPS financial resources.
