
Proposed Amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, The Traffic Bylaw – Speed Limit Changes

Recommendation

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9474, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2017 (No. 4)*.

Topic and Purpose

The purpose of this report is provide City Council with Bylaw No. 9474, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2017 (No. 4)*, which implements City Council's decision to establish and amend speed limits on a number of streets.

Report

At its September 25, 2017 Regular Business Meeting, City Council considered the report of the Standing Policy Committee on Transportation dated September 11, 2017, recommending approval of proposed amendments to Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw*.

City Council approved the proposed amendments, with the exception of recommendations 8 (relating to Millar Avenue) and 11 (relating to College Drive) which were defeated upon vote of City Council. At City Council's subsequent Regular Business Meeting on October 23, 2017, City Council resolved to amend Bylaw No. 7200, *The Traffic Bylaw* to also implement a speed reduction on College Drive. City Council directed the City Solicitor to prepare the necessary bylaw amendment.

In accordance with City Council's instructions, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9474, *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2017 (No. 4)* for City Council's consideration.
