Re: Food Waste and Reclamation [CK. 7830-1]

At its meeting held on April 12, 2018, the Saskatoon Environmental Advisory Committee received a presentation from Saskatoon Second Chance Food regarding food waste and reclamation.

Following the presentation the Committee resolved, in part:

That the Saskatoon Environmental Advisory Committee recommend to the Standing Policy Committee on Environment, Utilities, and Corporate Services:

1. That food reclamation be considered within the scope of the waste diversion planning including: the City consider a role in advocacy and communication for food reclamation;
2. That the City provide leadership by way of having City owned and operated venues participate where possible in existing food reclamation programs such as Food Renew; and
3. That the City participate in the Food Security Action Team by way of having a staff member sit on that Committee.

The Saskatoon Environmental Advisory Committee respectfully requests that this matter be placed before the Standing Policy Committee on Environment, Utilities, and Corporate Services for consideration at its next meeting.
