
Amendments to Bylaw No. 8286, The Smoking Control Bylaw, 2004

Recommendation

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9523, *The Smoking Control Amendment Bylaw, 2018*.

Topic and Purpose

The purpose of this report is provide City Council with Bylaw No. 9523, *The Smoking Control Amendment Bylaw, 2018*. If passed, this Bylaw would implement City Council's decision to amend Bylaw No. 8286, *The Smoking Control Bylaw, 2004* to broaden the restrictions of smoking in public places to include cannabis smoking.

Report

At its Regular Business Meeting on January 29, 2018, City Council supported a recommendation that smoking cannabis in public places be prohibited in the same way that smoking tobacco is prohibited.

City Council resolved that the City Solicitor prepare the necessary amendments to Bylaw No. 8286, *The Smoking Control Bylaw, 2004* to ensure that smoking cannabis in public places is to be prohibited in the same way that smoking tobacco is prohibited.

Since the time that this matter was first considered by City Council, the Provincial Government introduced Bill 121, *The Cannabis Control (Saskatchewan) Act*, which has, to date, received second reading. This Bill prohibits the use of cannabis in public places; the amendments to Bylaw No. 8286 are intended to mirror these prohibitions.

In accordance with City Council's instructions, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9523, *The Smoking Control Amendment Bylaw, 2018*, for City Council's consideration.
