BYLAW NO. 9522

The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2018 (No. 2)

The Council of The City of Saskatoon enacts:

Short Title

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Traffic Amendment Bylaw, 2018 (No. 2).*

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend *The Traffic Bylaw* to enact fees for temporary use of the right-of-way.

Bylaw No. 7200 Amended

3. The Traffic Bylaw is amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.

Section 52 Amended

4. Section 52 is repealed and the following substituted:

"Obstructing Sidewalk or Street

- 52. (1) A person shall not obstruct the free passage of traffic on any sidewalk or street without first securing a permit from the General Manager.
 - (2) A person who obtains a permit from the General Manager pursuant to this section shall comply with all of the provisions and conditions of the permit.
 - (3) A person who obtains a permit from the General Manager pursuant to this section shall provide the permit upon request by a police officer and the General Manager.
 - (4) The General Manager may impose fees for the issuance of a permit under this section as set out in Schedule No. 17.
 - (5) Nothing in this section shall be construed as prohibiting the gathering of individuals on any street for a lawful purpose so long as the

proceedings thereat are peaceable and orderly, and sufficient space is left both on the sidewalks and street to accommodate the ordinary traffic on the sidewalks and street."

Section 58.1 Amended

5. Subsection 58.1(5) is amended by striking out "as the General Manager considers appropriate" and substituting "as set out in Schedule No. 17".

Schedule No. 17 Added

6. Schedule "A" to this Bylaw is added as Schedule No. 17.

7. This Bylaw comes into force on the 1st day of January, 2019.

Schedule "A" to Bylaw No. 9522

"Schedule No. 17 Permit Fees for Use of Streets, Sidewalks or Boulevards

In this Schedule:

- (a) "high-traffic area" includes:
 - (i) all areas specifically listed below as high-traffic areas; and
 - (ii) any area that has equivalent traffic volumes or speeds to those areas specifically listed, which equivalence shall be determined solely by the General Manager; and
- (b) "lane" means any of the individual parallel strips into which the street is divided to form separate single lanes of traffic, and for greater certainty, sidewalks and exclusive bike lanes shall each constitute a separate lane.
