Team Skill Set, Experience, Reputation, and References (30 Points)

- Provide a listing of corporate and team experience in functional planning studies.
- Provide recent examples of similar successfully completed projects and how you propose to use that experience in this project.
- Provide a minimum of three (3) references for similar work.

Timeline and Schedule (10 Points)

- Provide a detailed work plan for the data collection, review, and reporting processes as it relates to Parking, Transportation, and Active Transportation.
- Include a work schedule that will chronicle the timeline of collection, review, and reporting that will be required.

Team Member Roles, Responsibilities, and Time Allocations (10 Points)

- Provide a detailed organizational chart of key team members.
- Provide a list of their experience and key skill sets and how their experience and knowledge will contribute to this project.
- Indicate how their time will be allocated to this project.
- Provide a description of the roles and responsibilities of team members.
