Water Accessibility by Building Type

All City facilities have access to a municipal water supply. However, the number of water fountains and types (e.g. fill station, kitchenette or standard spout water fountain) varies at each facility. Below is a table that outlines the current status of water accessibility and contract obligations with third-party vendors.

Outdoor Pools	Equipped with water fountains.	Expired in 2018. Currently negotiating a three year extension.
Nutrien Playland	Equipped with water fountains in the main entertainment area.	Expired in 2018. Currently negotiating a three year extension.
Golf Courses	Have water fountains indoors but no fill stations. Access to outdoor fountains on the golf course is limited.	Current contracts expire at the end of 2019, with an option to extend for two additional years.
