Designation of Chief Whitecap Park Off-Leash Recreation Area Amendment to Animal Control Bylaw, 1999, Bylaw No. 7860

Recommendation

That City Council consider Bylaw No. 9585, *The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw,* 2019.

Topic and Purpose

The purpose of this report is to provide City Council with Bylaw No. 9585, *The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2019,* which implements City Council's decision to amend Bylaw No. 7860, *The Animal Control Bylaw, 1999,* to establish approximately 80 acres as an off-leash recreation area within Chief Whitecap Park.

Report

At its meeting on April 29, 2019, City Council considered a report of the General Manager, Community Services Department, requesting approval to establish approximately 80 acres as an off-leash recreation area within Chief Whitecap Park and to instruct the City Solicitor to amend Bylaw No. 7860, *The Animal Control Bylaw, 1999.* In addition, a housekeeping amendment is required to remove the McOrmond Drive off-leash recreation area from the Bylaw as it is now being used for housing.

In accordance with City Council's instructions and to provide the necessary housekeeping amendment indicated above, we are pleased to submit Bylaw No. 9585, *The Animal Control Amendment Bylaw, 2019*, for City Council's consideration.
