I would like to urge the City to significantly modify or abandon the current plan to build a "Saskatoon Freeway" in close proximity to the newly-built North Commuter Parkway. Designation as a heritage land seems like an excellent option.

The Northeast Swale is a natural treasure. It is up to us as Saskatonians to ensure, through good stewardship and conservation, that it can remain so. It seems universally acknowledged that building the "Freeway" through the Swale will mean its end as a significant natural area.

The case for the Freeway has never been satisfactorily made.
