Service Level for Seasonal Lighting

Scope

Service Level (SL) documents are prepared to allow customers of the City of Saskatoon (City) to review and understand the services *currently* provided. This document includes activities completed under the 01-797 service line. This service is provided by Saskatoon Light & Power.

Service Overview - what we do

The Decorative Lighting Program provides lit and unlit seasonal decorations on street light poles in many of Saskatoon's major commercial areas in the winter season.

Saskatoon Light & Power completes the installation of the decorations by November 11th, turns them on by November 15th and operates from dusk to dawn. The decorations are turned off and removed after the spring equinox.

Decoration designs are selected by Community Services, Urban Design Group in consultation with SL&P and the BID's.

Purpose - why we do it

The Decorative Lighting Program provides a welcoming place and street activation, supporting the Winter City Strategy by providing more lighting to make the darker winter season more inviting and beautiful.

Decorations may conflict with other facilities installed on the poles such as pedestrian lighting, banners and communication devices.
